

Travelling from the May & Baker Way Car Park (yellow) to UCL's PEARL Building (blue)





Enter the car park from the May & Baker Way through a set of grey coloured gates. There is a large sign on the right hand side and a grey structure on the left hand side.



As you pass through the gates you will come to a mini roundabout. Cross straight over the roundabout. Keep driving through the car park. Spaces for PEARL are the last two rows of spaces on the left-hand side.



At the edge of the car park you will find a green turnstile. Enter the turnstile and go through out of the car park.



Travel down the path alongside the temporary fence past the bin. Keep walking along the path until you reach the edge of the industrial estate.





At the industrial estate you will see a black building directly ahead of you labelled UCL PEARL on the side on a copper and white sign. Walk towards this building using the walkway marked on the tarmac where possible.



Walk towards the sign and continue to follow the walkway marked by the figure of a person walking and an arrow. This path will lead you to the front of the PEARL building.



Continue to walk down the path. You will see a copper and black coloured building on your right hand side. This is the PEARL building.



Once you reach the car park in front of the building with the wave shaped roof turn right. The front of the PEARL building will be on your left. It will have a large sign with the words UCL on the side. Walk to the white sign that reads PEARL to find the door.
