make their spaces more accessible.



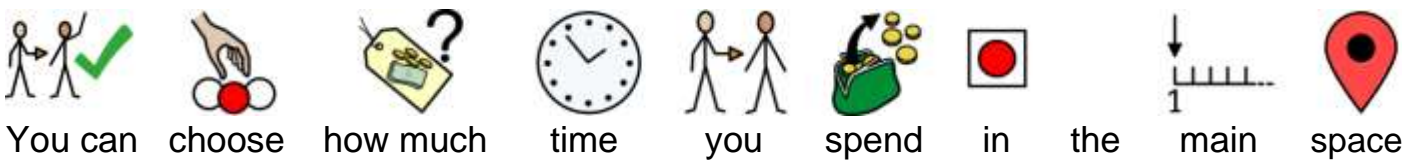

You can choose how much time you spend in the main space



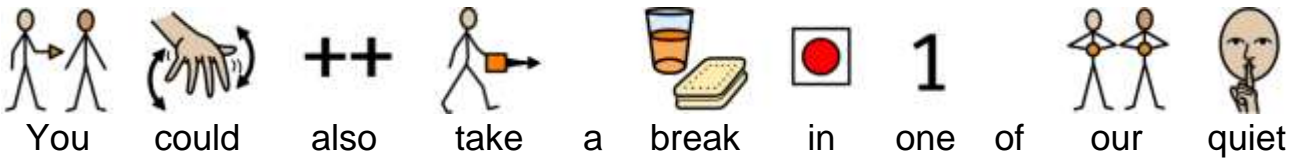

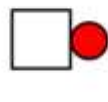
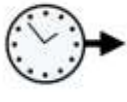
After the 45 minutes are over, you will be asked to
